



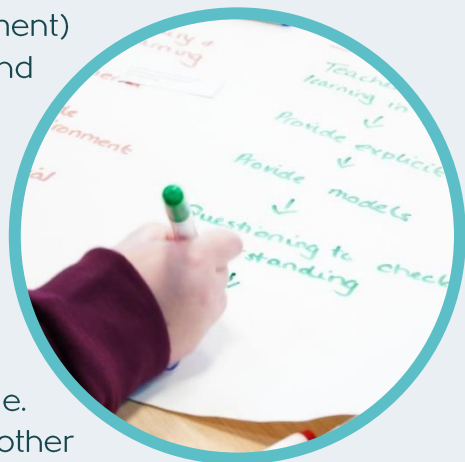
# Specialist Teaching Assistant

## Apprenticeship Level 5

This 24-month apprenticeship (inclusive of End Point Assessment) equips you with the skills to support learners in primary and special schools.

As a Specialist Teaching Assistant, you'll work with students, often focusing on areas like Special Educational Needs (SEND), social and emotional well-being, or specialised curriculum areas such as EAL, forest schools, or music education.

Your role will involve planning, delivering, and adapting learning activities using research-based strategies and reflective practice. You'll build strong relationships with students, families, staff and other education professionals, contributing to an inclusive and supportive learning environment. You will support individual and group learning, ensure student safety, assist with assessments, and may also provide training to colleagues in your specialist area.

- End Point Assessments at the end of the programme which will demonstrate your knowledge

- **Desirable** - GCSE Grade C/4+ or equivalent in English, Maths and Science
