



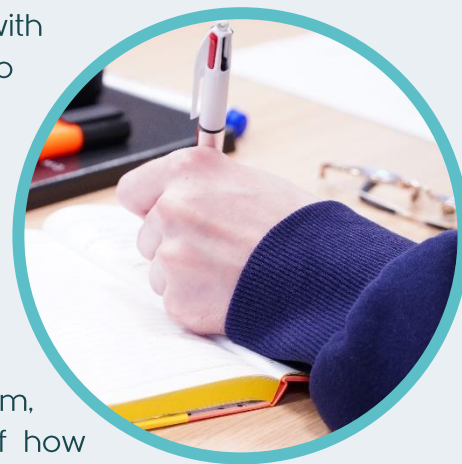
# Teaching Assistant

## Apprenticeship Level 3

Our Level 3 Teaching Assistant Apprenticeship will provide you with an in depth understanding of the knowledge and skills needed to work directly with pupils and young people in school.

Studying with us, you will gain a nationally recognised qualification (2xA Level equivalent), learn alongside a group of colleagues and have the support of an experienced tutor, in addition to a school based mentor to support you through your professional studies.

You will cover aspects such as understanding the curriculum, supporting behaviour in school and gain an understanding of how pupils learn and develop.

### Who is this Course for

This apprenticeship is ideal for teaching assistants, or someone in a similar role, who want to develop their skills. Teaching assistants play a vital role in supporting pupils to reach their full potential. Our programme of learning helps you to provide the best possible education for the pupils in your care. You will explore educational theories and strategies, taken from the latest educational research, and you will have the opportunity to apply any new learning back in your setting.



## How is this Apprenticeship Delivered?

Over 18 months, learners study the following modules (face to face training modules over 8 half-terms):

- Understanding and supporting behaviour in schools
- Understanding how pupils learn and develop
- Developing pupils to become independent learners
- Understanding the curriculum
- Working with teachers to understand and support assessment for learning
- Understanding the role and making effective use of teaching assistants
- Keeping children safe in education
- Delivering targeted support

Learners will be supported to develop a portfolio of evidence, with tasks set from each delivery session which allow learners to apply their learning back in the classroom through their off-the-job training time.

Once all learning is complete, an End Point Assessment is arranged. This is made up of an observation and a professional discussion and is supported by the portfolio.

## Entry Requirements

- Valid and eligible residency status
- Employer agreement
- Currently working as a Teaching Assistant or a similar role
- English and Maths at Functional skills or GCSE level – desirable although not essential\*

\* As this course is the equivalent standard to 2 A level qualifications a good grasp of the English language is required to access the written content and expectations from the start of the course.

*It is no longer a requirement for apprentices to have functional skills L2 qualifications to proceed to End Point Assessment of this course, however, having good English and Maths qualifications are important for most careers and we want to give apprentices the help they need to succeed. Therefore, it is our preference that all learners have functional skills L2 qualifications.*
